Mechanism for Redressing Students' Ragging Issues

The college is bound by the UGC regulations on 'Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Education Institutions 2009'. The college has anti-ragging committee which comprises an incharge and 10 faculty members. The committee ensures the prevention of ragging either within the college or outside the college.

The actions taken to prohibit or minimize instances of ragging are as follows:

- All the students admitted to the college are informed to go through the guidelines of anti-ragging.
- Contact numbers of the members of anti-ragging committee are published in the Prospectus and displayed prominently on boards put up at different locations in the campus.
- Anti-ragging squad of the college ensures vigil at odd hours during first few months inside the college campus.
- In the beginning of academic session, Anti-Ragging committee conducts meeting to discuss the channel to receive students' complaint and mechanism to resolve the issues.
- Students can register their complaints orally as well as in written form. In order to maintain the documentation and to realize the seriousness of complaint to both the parties (the complainant and the respondent) written complaints are preferred.
- If the written complaint is received, the committee members analyse the nature of complaint / issue; accordingly the complainant and the respondent are given chance individually to give details of the incident.
- Once the proceeding is completed, the committee tries to collect evidence for the incident and prepares its report which is forwarded to the Principal so that any disciplinary action is taken against the student indulging in ragging.

On account of these measures, the college has never received any ragging complaint till date.
